Town Center Planters

The reconstruction of Main Street in the late 1990s left the town's center with several expanses of barren road-side brick. Interested citizens planted the first planters in 2000 to bring color to the brick peninsulas by Daybreak Coffee. Since then the number of Town Center planters has grown to more than 50 that can be found along Main St. and Hebron Ave. Although businesses purchase most of the pots and pay for the annuals, volunteers plant and maintain the planters during the growing season.
